Fundraising Report

Beausejour skating club ran three fundraisers this year - Little Caesar's, 50/50 and Perfect Pierogies/Timothy's butcher shop.

Pizza kit sales totalled \$7322, which was down from last year's sales of \$9818. The club was shorted 4 cookie kits for which we were reimbursed. The total profit on the kits sold was \$1416, with the net profit to the club after expenses (\$125 for mileage, \$44.75 for trailer rental) being \$1245.85.

50/50 ticket sales totalled \$2458, which was also down from last year. \$1229 went to the winner, with the club receiving \$1131.60 after printing and lottery license costs.

The club sold 308 dozen Pierogies for a total profit to the club of \$770. Meat sales totalled \$2734 with a profit to the club of \$820.20.
